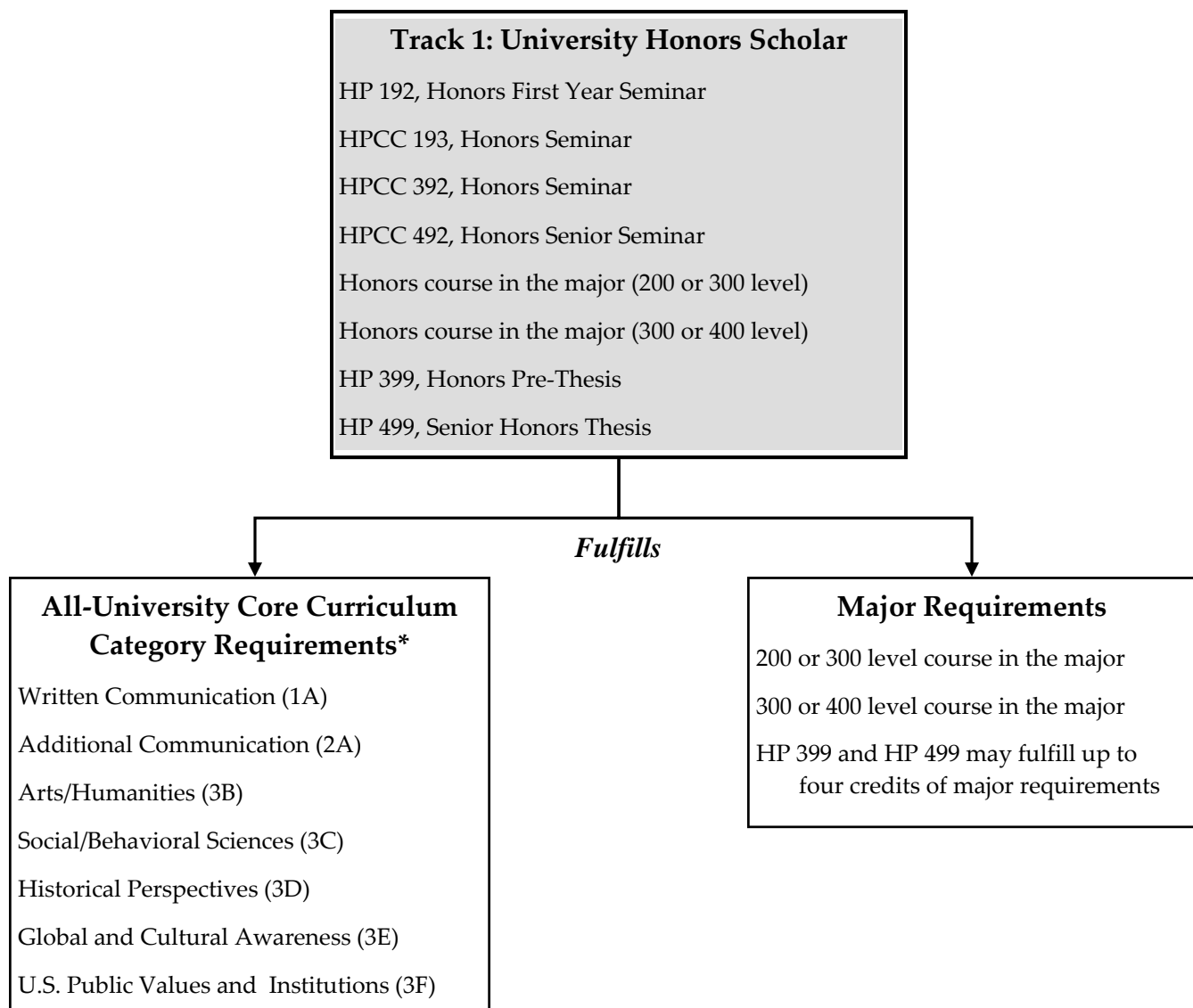


Track 1: University Honors Scholar

Track 1 fulfills the majority of the University's general education requirements (All-University Core Curriculum, or AUCC) and is well suited for incoming first-year students without significant transfer credits. Track 1 is a 23 credit program of study that consists of four interdisciplinary Honors seminars, two Honors courses in the student's major, the Honors pre-thesis, and the senior Honors thesis. Track 1 fulfills 21 credits of the All-University Core Curriculum and 6-10 credits in the student's major. The diagram below illustrates the AUCC and major requirements fulfilled by Track 1. Students who complete Track 1 with at least a 3.5 cumulative GPA receive the designation of University Honors Scholar on their diplomas and transcripts.



*The Honors Core Curriculum for Track 1 (University Honors Scholar) fulfills seven of the eleven AUCC categories. Students must fulfill the remaining four categories to complete the University's general education requirements: Mathematics (1B), Logical/Critical Thinking (2B), Biological/ Physical Sciences (3A), and Health and Wellness (3G). Special Honors sections of regular courses are offered in these categories.
